## Route 2: Stone Head/Story/Valley Branch Loop (All Paved)

- From the Visitors Center in Nashville, head south on Van Buren Street less than a ¼ mile and turn left at the stoplight onto State Road 46 East. Continue on just over 3 miles (passing by the north entrance of <u>Brown</u> <u>County State Park</u>), then turn right onto State Road 135 South.
- 2. Soak in the fall foliage as you follow the winding State Road 135 South for 5 miles until you reach a T in the road; you're at **Stone Head!** Behind the tourist home at the T is Stone Head Nature Preserve with its 5 miles of public hiking trails.
- 3. At the Stone Head T, turn right to continue on State Road 135 for just over 4 miles until you arrive at **Story**!
  - Founded in 1851, the quaint village of Story has become the Story Inn, Indiana's oldest country inn. Here you'll find overnight lodging, a gourmet restaurant housed in the former general store, a tavern, gardens, and resident ghost, "The Blue Lady."
- 4. Leaving Story, take State Road 135 (past Story's cabins and cottages) about 3 miles to a left turn onto Hamilton Creek Road.
  - Tip: For a pitstop along Hamilton Creek Road, you'll find the Homestead Weaving Studio; home to local artist Chris Gustin and his handwoven rugs, clothing and more!
- 5. Follow Hamilton Creek Road just under 5 miles to a T in the road, where you'll turn left onto Bellesville Pike. Continue 1 mile to reach Stone Head once again.







- 6. At Stone Head, take a right back onto State Road 135 South for just a ½ mile before making another right onto Valley Branch Road.
  - If you're feeling adventurous, stop by <u>eXplore Brown County at</u> <u>Valley Branch Retreat</u> for zip lining, hiking, mountain biking, paintball, ATV tours, and more!
- 7. Following along Valley Branch Road just over 4 miles will take you straight back to the familiar State Road 46 East. Turn left, taking you through little Gnaw Bone, Indiana; home to <a href="Bear Wallow Distillery">Bear Wallow Distillery</a>, <a href="Brown County Winery">Brown County Winery</a>, <a href="Gnaw Bone Coffee">Gnaw Bone Coffee</a>, and <a href="Brown County Winery">Brown County Winery</a>, <a href="Gnaw Bone Coffee">Gnaw Bone Coffee</a>, and <a href="Brown County Winery">Brown County</a> <a href="Antique Mall">Antique Mall</a>. Hit them all on the way back to the town of Nashville!

Total mileage to each stop on route = Approx. 30 miles

- 1. Less than 1/4 mile from Visitors Center to stoplight at intersection of State Road 46 East
- 2. 3.4 miles from stoplight to State Road 135 South
- 3. 5 miles down State Road 135 South to the T in the road at Stone Head
- 4. 4.4 miles from Stone Head to Story
- 5. 3 miles from Story to Hamilton Creek Road
- 5 miles from Hamilton Creek Road to Bellesville Pike, then 1 mile to Stone Head
- 7. ½ mile from Stone Head to Valley Branch Road, then 4.4 miles to State Road 46 East
- 8. 5.5 miles down State Road 46 East from Valley Branch Road to the town of Nashville
