This year's reception kicks off with a panel discussion by artists C.W. Mundy and Rita Spalding highlighting their artist residencies at T.C. Steele State Historic Site. Spalding is the first artist since T.C. Steele to paint indoors in the House of the Singing Winds. Check out her display inside the historic home.
